Notes From the "Hurricane Dorian House 2 Slumber Party" with Brooke, Louann and Sam!



Thank you, Jolynn, for giving BCR hope through your generosity!











Welcome to our Sponsor Spotlight! The BCR family is full of wonderful people who truly love the cats and we want you to meet them! Each sponsor is given a set of questions to answer and asked to send along their favorite photos of their sponsor cats. Are you interested in being in the Sponsor Spotlight? How did you first learn about BCR?

I am not sure, but I think it was through the book Homer's Odyssey. Not long after reading that book. I rescued two eightweek-old feral kittens with terrible eye infections (from the herpes virus). I guess I needed some assurance that I would be able to provide a safe home for them, if they survived (it was December and they were both quite frail). My neighbor took the male kitten and I took the female. Both recovered from their medical issues and are now five-and-a-half years old, blind in both eyes but very happy and healthy. The compassion that BCR shows for these unwanted animals (blind, FIV or FeLV positive) really inspired me and I have since become involved with TNR, fostering, and educating people about special needs cats. I have supported BCR ever since.

Have you visited and, if so, what did you enjoy most? What surprised you most?

I visited about four years ago while I was on a business trip that took me to Raleigh. I think the most surprising thing is that BCR looks nothing like the traditional idea of an animal shelter. There are no cement floors and small wire cages. It looks like a home. The cats are in such a relaxing setting. Everything is clean. The cats are all so friendly and look so healthy. Despite such a large number of cats, I feel like everyone gets individual attention. It is such a special sanctuary. I hope I can visit again soon and stay longer and maybe even help out for a day.



What cat or cats do you sponsor? Why did you choose them?

I like to say Marge chose me. When I sat on the floor, a number of cats came to investigate. Several of them climbed on me and were very friendly and sweet. Marge basically plopped on my lap, purred happily, and did her best to discourage any other cats from claiming me. I have a special affinity for black cats (I am owned by three, including my blind girl). It was a very easy decision to sponsor her. I cried when I learned of her passing, but also grateful to BCR for saving her and giving her a great life. I know she was happy there because I witnessed that myself. I later decided to sponsor Richey, since he has the same name as my favorite uncle. I

hope to be able to visit Richey soon.

If you could tell people one thing about BCR, what would it be?

BCR is a haven for special needs cats who might otherwise be automatically euthanized in most shelters due to their supposed un-adoptability. It is a true blessing!

Dash is a very lucky girl! This shy, leukemia-positive kitten came from Animal Control in Tennessee. She was part of an effort to trap and fix 100 stray cats in an a trailer park. You read that right, 100 cats! Animal Control found homes for the friendliest cats they trapped. Dash was in that group until she tested positive for leukemia, an immediate death sentence. Thankfully, the vet just could not euthanize a healthy, sweet kitten, saving her life. She along with Dot and Elvis - are the the first leukemia-positive cats their shelter has ever been able to successfully find a home for. Dash is a little shy still but very sweet.
