Spray peppermint oil on the tree - this idea helped LOTS of people



With all the helpful ideas out there, everyone agrees on a couple of safety tips. The first is not to put tinsel and angel hair on your Christmas tree. While they may look really pretty, cats get very interested in them and they can cause intestinal blockages or choking if eaten by a cat. Tree lights are another hazard for cats who tend to chew on wires. To be safe, unplug the lights at night and frequently check the exposed parts for teeth marks. If you see your cat start to drool, have difficulty breathing, or seem to have unusual mental or physical problems, that could indicate electric shock. Check the wires to be sure and if you see chew marks, get your cat to the vet asap. It may seem strange but the water in the tree base keeping your tree green can also be poisonous to your cat if it includes additives or if fertilizer seeps into it. Best to have a covered tree base.

Holiday decorating is so much fun and makes our homes seem so festive at the holidays! No need to skip it if you have cats, just be aware and make some adjustments so everyone enjoys the tree!

How did you first learn about BCR?

I first learned about BCR on Facebook in the fall/winter of 2016. One of BCR's live tours came up on my feed and I fell in love right away! I started watching the tour and then went to the Facebook page and website to learn more. I was hooked!

Have you visited and if so, what did you enjoy the most? What surprised you the most?

I have had the wonderful opportunity to visit four times now. I am fortunate to live close enough to drive there, from Baltimore, MD (5-6 hours). My first visit was October 2018 (Building 3 was not there yet), and my most recent trip was last month, in October, right before Halloween. I absolutely loved spending time with the cats and getting to know their personalities in person. I also loved getting to know Alana and the staff, some of whom have become some of the greatest friends I have ever had!

I was surprised by a few things. The first is - and I know everyone says this - but it is so extremely clean. I don't just mean the cleanliness of the litter boxes, floors, and beds, but also the dishes, water fountains, all of the toys, kurandas, the lobby and especially how organized everything is. With more than 100 cats living there it is just incredible how everything was kept track of and how easy it is to find everything. Watching the staff set up the daily medicines, wet food 3x a day, the vet files/records for each cat, where to find the food, litter, bedding, toys (in the biggest cat nip container I have ever seen!), laundry/dish soap, and storage for everything. It was funny to see the actual size of the cats as well. Some of the bigger cats like Boone, Sterling, Scotty and Licorice look big on the screen but they are quite a bit bigger when you see them in person! The smaller cats like Greta, Gina and Angel are really small when you see them!



What cats do you sponsor? Why did you choose them?

I currently sponsor CiCi, Licorice, and Chester. The first cat I sponsored was Dominic (leukemia +). I was trying to decide who it would be when I saw his name. Dominic was my grandfather's name so it drew me in to read his story. After hearing his story and watching him on the tours, I was in love! When he crossed over the rainbow bridge I had to transfer my sponsorship to another cat. It was so difficult to decide who it would be and this is how I first met staff member Melinda! After a bunch of emails and messages, we started talking about CiCi. Well, needless to say, after learning how she ended up finding her forever home at BCR and that she needed sponsors, I made the decision to pick the diva herself!! When Charlotte arrived, I cannot explain it but I just had to be a part of her life somehow! She won my heart with her little "blep" she had all the time and her playful and loving spirit. After Charlotte crossed over the bridge (she was a leukemia + kitty with a few other health issues she had prior to arriving at BCR), I again found myself trying to figure out who to transfer the sponsorship to. I sadly never had the chance to meet Dominic or Charlotte, but after my first visit to BCR a few kitties had taken pieces of my heart. Some of the ones I was



deciding between had a lot of sponsors, and then I saw on Licorice's page he only had two at the time. (All of the money goes to all of the cats - so regardless of how many sponsors they have they all get the same amazing care). So, Licorice it was!

After following BCR for almost three years and spending a lot of time with Chester on my visits I had fallen so head over heels in love with him. I thought about it a lot and I had to be one of his sponsors! He is just one of the funniest cats I have ever seen/met. He would always put a smile on my face and was so much fun to play with - if he was carrying my arm around the room or climbing on me and sitting on my shoulders- again, like the others, I just had to be part of his life somehow! (He is from MD, too!)

If you could tell people one thing about BCR, what would it be?

The one thing I would tell people is that BCR is such an amazing sanctuary for these cats and what Alana Miller has done to save all of these lives is simply phenomenal. The amount of time, effort, and work that goes into having this sanctuary is just more than one could imagine. She is truly one of the angels that walks among us. Something I am not sure everyone knows or realizes is this that BCR is on her personal property. She opens her home to these cats and for everyone to see and visit. There is 100% transparency with the live tours, the opening of boxes on Fridays and Saturdays, the visiting hours (Monday-Saturday 12-4, volunteer to help clean 7:30-12) and the 24 hour Zmodo cameras you can watch all day every day - no other sanctuary has anything like this! I am so very thankful I found BCR. It has given me a sense of purpose I had been looking for, for quite some time. I will always be a supporter/sponsor and do anything and everything I possibly can for Alana, and the beautiful cats that call BCR home.
