The good news is that we came through with minimal damage! We had some fencing blow down, knee deep water in the horses' pen, some damage and a leak in the guest house, a branch or two down and we lost power for a while. It was a tough few days getting through the hurricane that wouldn't leave - from slogging back and forth in the rain, monitoring generators (we were turning them off at night to conserve fuel, not knowing how long we'd be without power), to making sure the houses were dry and being with the cats.

BUT...Power is back on now, the fences are mended and we're working on the guest house, which we hope to reopen soon. All in all, with some good preparation by the BCR staff - and with all the prayers and positive thoughts from YOU - the cats were safe and happy all the time!

In case one of these events comes your way...

Alana's Hurricane Lessons:

- Pay attention! If there's a hurricane out in the ocean even if they aren't sure of its path
 start buying water early! The worst that will happen is you'll have extra water and
 you won't get stuck when the stores run out!
- Be sure to buy enough supplies for two weeks. It could take that long before your local stores restock. (Ours are just now seeing fresh foods arrive.)

- A portable phone charger is worth its weight in gold. We always use one during tours when the cell phone battery is low. If the power goes out, they're essential.
- It gets really hot without A/C so a portable fan comes in very handy!
- Finally, make sure to load up your iPad or other device with videos and books so you aren't bored to death!


