What we learned from this experience - Three easy tips for keeping your Facebook account safe:

- Change your password! Make it complicated.
- Enable two-tier authorization at log in.
- Do not click any links you get in Facebook Messenger.

Several people were hacked via links sent to them on Messenger. The things you get on Messenger may not actually be from the person you think is sending them. Always verify who's really contacting you if you're asked to click on something or


send information.




Order "My Life in a Cat House" by Gwen Cooper
